'A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM' AT THEATRE BOX**

FLORAL PARK, N.Y.—Oh, what delightful fools these talented mortals be, as Theatre Box of Floral Park presents William Shakespeare's hilarious romp "A Midsummer Night's Dream" for six performances between Friday, July 28 and Saturday, Aug. 5 at United Methodist Church, 35 Verbena Ave.

Shakespeare's immortal comedy concerns the interactions of two pairs of star-crossed lovers, a group of amateur actors, woodland fairies, and a duke and duchess. Along the way, spells are cast which cause the couples to fall in love with the wrong persons.
